Barrington Highway Department Clean-Up Day Roadside Pick Up Guidelines

Early Trash Bag Pick Up

-Trash bags are available for pick up in the Barrington Highway Department Office starting Monday, April 15 at 9:00. We kindly ask that if roadside clean ups take place earlier than April 20,2024 that bags are not dropped off till the day of the event. ****We are using specific trash bags and separate W/M container for this event which will be located at the Highway Department** Town bags will not be accepted for this event!**

Day of Trash Bag Pick Up

-Volunteers may pick up trash bags on Saturday April 20 starting at 8:00 am at the Barrington Highway Department, 226 Smoke Street.

General

- Prior to completing your roadside pick-up, review these guidelines with all members of your Clean Up Day group.
- Make sure all volunteer vehicles are not parked in the road. There is a year-round parking ordinance in Town.
- Respect private property. Do not go onto property behind fences or gates with "Private Property" or "No Trespassing" signs.
- Children should always be supervised by adults.

Litter

- All litter should be bagged
- If volunteers find appliances, televisions, furniture, or other large items, please make note of the item and location. Share this information with someone at the Highway Department so future removal can be scheduled.
- Do not overfill trash bags. Filling bags over capacity will make them very difficult to be picked up.
- Use caution when collecting litter. Do not attempt to collect trash that is in any location that may pose a danger for you to access.

Hazardous Items

- In the event that a needle/syringe is found, do not touch it. Have an adult stand watch and call the Barrington Police Department so that they may properly dispose of it.
- Do not handle any hazardous or potentially hazardous materials.

What to wear/Bring

- Wear gloves when picking up litter
- Wear closed toed, flat heeled shoes. No sandals or flip flops
- Wear bright colored, long sleeved clothing to protect your skin and be visible to vehicles.
- Wear sunblock and bug spray may be useful in spots located near wooded areas.
- Bring a water bottle to stay hydrated
