Municipal Highway Classifications

Class V:

Class V consists of all traveled highways other than Class VI that the town or city has the duty to maintain regularly. A Class V road can be anything from a one-lane dirt track to a six-lane boulevard.

Class VI:

Class VI consists of "all other existing public ways". It includes all local highways discontinued subject to gates and bars and all highways that have not been maintained and repaired by the town in suitable condition for travel for five successive years or more. It is important to recognize at the outset that Class VI highways are full public highways in every respect except for maintenance.
