1. Reviewed, made minor edits to the April 30 meeting minutes. Edit change to include attendence of Rob Gibson at the meeting and on item #5 to include spacing for Map 224.

- 2. Reviewed and discussed the list of proposed properties for sale provided at the meeting. See the <u>2022 Potential Town-Owned Property Sale List</u> for details.
 - 346 Berry River Road consider remove no-build restriction and amend to allow a shed or addition to a current abutters home. No new residential structure.
 - Long Shores accept low bid from abutter or local road association with no residential structure allowed
 - 715 Long Shores consider remove no-build restriction and amend to allow a shed or addition to a current abutters home. No new residential structure.
 - 129 Long Shores auction with no build restrictions
 - 37 Washington auction no restrictions
 - 49 Nippo Court auction consider remove no-build restriction and amend to allow a shed or addition to a current abutters home. No new residential structure.
 - 120 Tolend Road sell at auction
 - 22 and 29 Calef Highway consider merge and auction with access from Substitute Road. NH DOT possibly has a controlled access on Rte. 125. Lot 29 is not a tax property need to research any restrictions.

3. Discussion on Homestead Property – property has been approved for sale by the town and a plan needs to be developed to clean up the property as a condition of sale for the auction.

- The two structures, the boat, the associated trash and any additional debris will need to be removed by the purchaser within one year of final sale.
- The rock pile and the presumed lot line issues will not need to be addressed.
- The property will be sold with a reserve price to include all fees and taxes owed.
